Application Guidelines

REMINDER: This scholarship application must be accompanied by:

- a. An essay which describes your reason for **1. pursuing a higher education, 2. your plans for the future, and 3. the financial need you foresee as a college student**
 - i. Minimum of 500 words.
 - ii. Maximum 1000 words
 - iii. Double Space
- b. Individual Action Plan (IAP), must be completed with ILP/B:E case manager/coach
- c. 2 letters of recommendation, **excluding letters from B:E/ILP staff**
 - i. One letter is allowed to be a personal references
 - ii. Ideas for references:
 - School Counselor
 - Pastor
 - Social Worker
 - Teacher
 - Supervisor
- d. Intent to Graduate form signed by school administration
- e. High school transcripts/GED completion form
- f. Scholarship Checklist form, and

This step will be completed after you are notified that you will receive the scholarship

- I. Evidence of vocational or college enrollment (**monies will be disbursed once this step is complete**)
 - i. Classes schedule and college acceptance letter
- II. **You have one year from award date to submit appropriate paperwork to receive the scholarship award amount. Please submit before June 2020 in order to stay eligible for ILP Scholarship.**

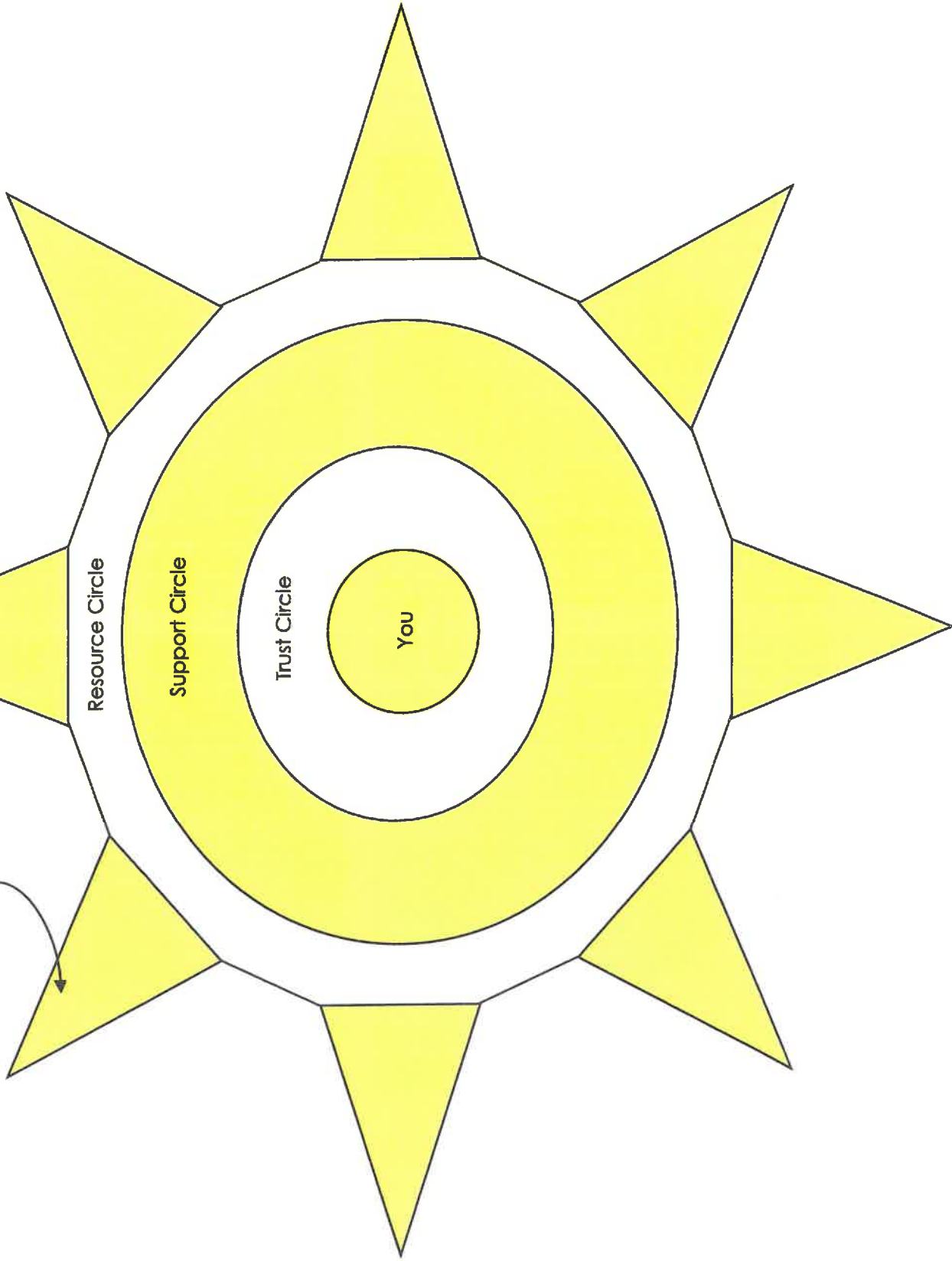

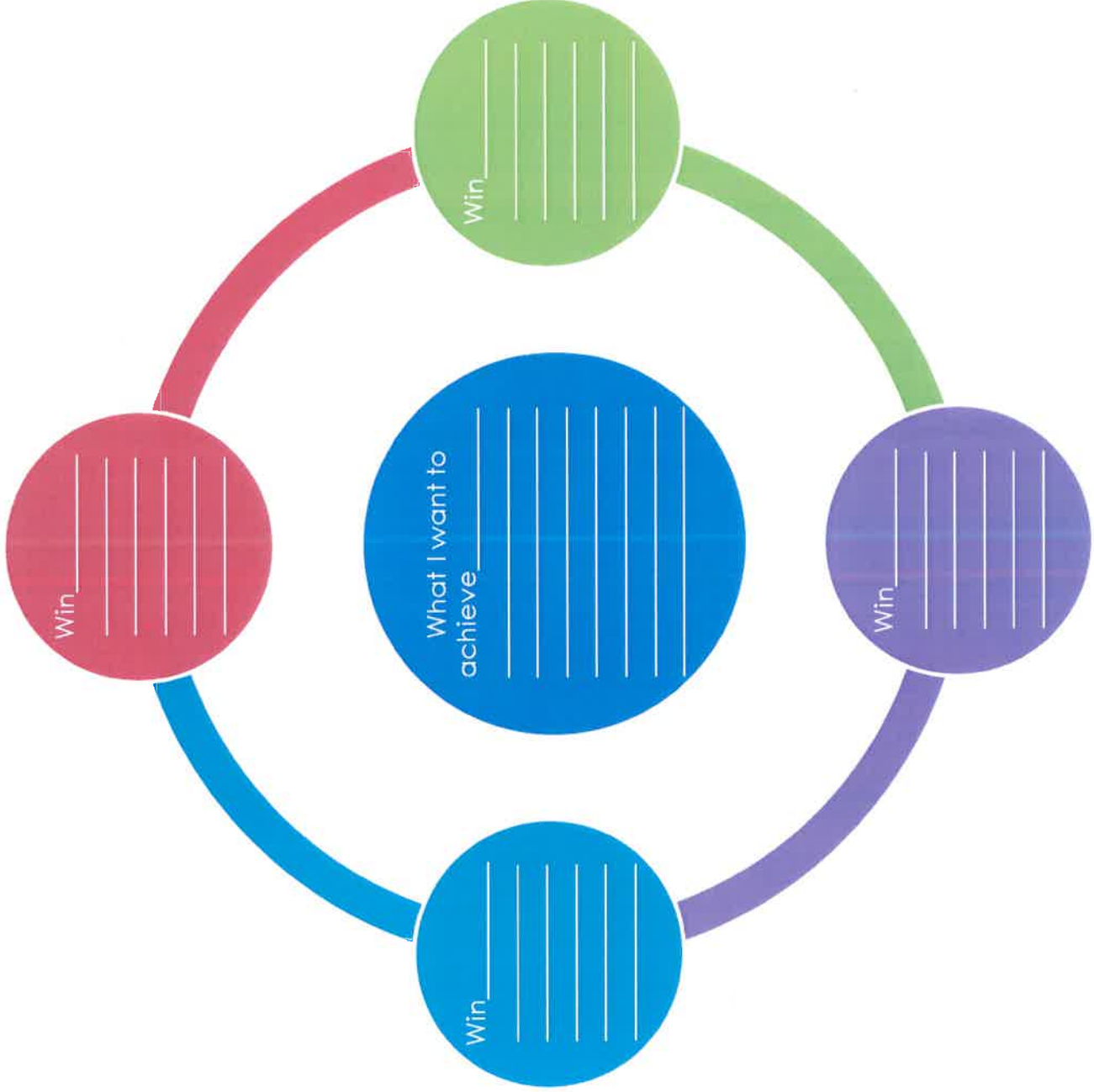

Criteria and Guidelines for ILP Scholarship

The application process has changed. Below you will find the directions to follow as staff. For client directions, see the scholarship application.

1. Available: January 7, 2019 to May 3rd, 2019
2. Deadline May 3rd (This is a strict deadline. We want all seniors participating in the graduation to receive their confirmation of reward by the ILP graduation ceremony)
 - a. All documents to be turned into ILP Educational/Career Specialist by **5pm on Friday May 3rd, 2019 (No exceptions)**
3. A complete & thorough action plan (A TILP will not be accepted in exchange for the action plan)
4. Please proofread youth client's essay before submission.
 - a. Ed workshops will be conducted at North & South county offices geared toward personal statements and the ILP scholarship process.
5. Youth applying for the ILP scholarship must participate in ILP workshops or distant learning for a minimum of 6 times throughout the year. (no exceptions)
6. Provide proof of youth attendance in ILP.
