



## Criteria and Guidelines for the ILP Scholarship

Every year Alameda County ILP grants scholarships of up to \$5,000 to ILP eligible youth in efforts to support their post-secondary goals and attain higher education. The following instructions are intended to support both youth and their coach through the application process.

### Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be ILP eligible and enrolled
2. Must be pursuing post-secondary education Fall 2022-Spring 2023 (**Proof of enrollment must be submitted if selected for scholarship**)

### Application Details:

1. Open: March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022 to June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 5pm for **FIRST-TIME Applicants ONLY**. \*Deadline: **June 6<sup>th</sup>** (**This is a hard deadline. All awardees will be announced at our BE/ILP graduation ceremony**)
  - All documents to be turned into an Educational/Career Coach by the youth or coach by **5pm on Monday, June 6<sup>th</sup>** (**No exceptions**)
2. A completed **education and career action plan** as well as signed valid **TILP**
3. **Essay**. Please proofread essays before submission.
  - Three education workshops will be conducted virtually and are geared towards providing support with personal statements and the ILP scholarship application process.
4. **Two letters of recommendation, One letter is allowed to be a personal reference** (ex. School Counselor/Admin/Teacher, Coach, Social Worker, Supervisor)



**5. Intent to Graduate form** signed by school administration AND **High school transcripts/GED completion form**

6. Youth applying for the ILP scholarship must have participated in at least **3 ILP activities** (This can be done by workshops, distant learning, virtual workshops etc.) beginning **August 2021 to present**. \*If youth have not attended 3 events, attending the ILP Scholarship workshop series will suffice.

## Application Guidelines

**REMINDER:** This scholarship application must be accompanied by:

- a. **Essay Prompt: 1. Describe yourself and why you want to pursue a higher education? What motivates you to accomplish this goal? 2. What are your career and future goals? and 3. How will this scholarship help your financial needs as a post-secondary student?**

Minimum of 500 words, Maximum 1500 words. Double Spaced.

- b. **Education Action Plan (EAP), must be completed with ILP/B:E case manager/coach**

**\*\*This step will be completed after you are notified that you will receive the scholarship:**

- i. Evidence of vocational or college enrollment (**money will be disbursed once this step is complete**)
  - i. Classes schedule and college acceptance letter

**You have one year from award date to submit appropriate paperwork to receive the scholarship award amount. Please submit before June 1st 2022 in order to stay eligible for ILP Scholarship.**
